### **Stabling:**

\$50.00 for duration of the show, additional nights \$15.00. 40 12'X12' permanent and 60 10' X 10' stalls available on show grounds. Shavings will be available for \$8.00 per bag. 1st set-up included, any additional shavings needed, can be purchased. Stalls open Friday, July 4th at 12:00 PM and close Monday, July 7th at 6:00 PM. Special arrangements considered, please call Manager/Secretary.

Camping is free with stabling. No hookups allowed.

### **Out of State Horses:**

Horses coming from out of state must have negative Coggins, state of origin brand inspection or proof of ownership; current health certificate along with entry permit #. This # can be obtained by your Vet at time of exam—call Federal Vet in Helena (406) 444-2976. There is no charge for this service.

**Awards:**

Ribbons through 6th place in each class. High Percentage Awards are based on the highest average percentage of the two best tests for Training Level, First Level, Second Level, Third Level, Fourth Level, FEI, Adult Amateur and Junior Young Rider.

Many SPECIAL AWARDS including;

GOOD SEAT AWARD, FARTHEST DISTANCE AWARD, BREED AWARDS, GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, American Trakehner Association High Score Awards (must submit a copy of horses papers to be eligible) and many more. There will be a photographer/video person on the grounds during the show hours.

**Arenas:**

Two (2) 20X60M outdoor competition arenas, both have sand and airfoot footing. Warm up has sand and airfoot footing.

**Concession:**

On grounds during show hours.

**Farrier and Veterinarian:**

Will be on call. First Aid assistance on grounds. EMT on grounds during shows and Friday afternoon. Telephone numbers to be posted in show office.

*From Junction of Hwy. 93 & 2:* Travel 2 mi. north on Hwy. 93 (toward Whitefish) to Reserve Loop (Just before Costco). Go west. Go straight through round-a-bout. Travel 1 mile past round-a-bout to Spring Creek Rd. Go south on Spring Creek; Event entrance 3/4 mile on right.

*From North:* Follow Hwy. 93 South to West Reserve Rd. Go west. Turn right at stop sign. Go straight through round-a-bout. Travel 1 mile past round-a-bout to Spring Creek Rd. Go south on Spring Creek; Event entrance 3/4 mile on right.

*From West:* Follow Hwy 2 to Meridian Rd. Go left onto Meridian to 3 Mile Drive. Go left onto 3 Mile Drive. Follow road about 3 miles to sharp turn to the left. Go right at bend onto gravel road. Turn left at 'T' and then an immediate right. The farm entrance is about 1/4 mile on the left.
